Supported accommodation

235 local young people provided with a safe place to call home within the Woolwich or Dartford areas

100 of these young people successfully moved on to fully independent living

Nursery & after school services

142 children enrolled in our Early Years Foundation Stage settings

Youth services in Woolwich

1068 young people engaged with our detached service

59 young people engaged through our schools mentoring

120 unique young people engaged with our weekly clubs

Health & Wellbeing services

37 stroke and brain injury rehabilitation classes provided over the year with an average attendance of 10 local people each week

Across the wider organisation....

- Supported accommodation: Provided safe housing for over 700 people facing homelessness
- Cancer rehab at YMCA Romford: 54 adults completed our free 10-week exercise programme to regain strength and confidence
- Senior citizens' group: Hosted 102 weekly meetups averaging 19 older adults each, reducing isolation and fostering community
- Specialist fitness classes: Delivered 272 seated sessions and 81 circuit classes in Romford and Dartford to boost physical and mental wellbeing.
- Horizons, our West Kent Training and Education service: provided alternative Post-16 education to 23 young people with SEND, helping them achieve 21 qualifications. An additional 26 local students joined day release programmes
- Luke Shotter, one of our dedicated young workers at our Goods Station Road shop, was awarded the National YMCA Young Achiever of the Year Award.
