Annual Update



Supported accommodation

- **326** local young people provided with a safe place to call home within the Romford and Brentwood areas
- 158 of these young people successfully moved on to fully independent living

Nursery & after school services

- **38** children enrolled in our Early Years Foundation Stage settings
- 19.701 places at our breakfast and after school wrap around services available to local families
- **1656** holiday club places helping to support working families

Health & Wellbeing services

- **54** adults living with cancer joined our free 10-week cancer rehab programme
- 102 free social groups for senior citizens took place over the last year, run twice per week with an average of 19 in attendance each week
- specialist seated classes for mobility impaired members of our community took place over the year
- **81** Specialist circuit classes using TRX equipment offered unique exercise opportunities for people with disabilities or long-term health conditions.



Across the wider organisation....

- Supported accommodation: we've provided safe, supported housing for over 700 individuals facing homelessness
- Our youth services across south east London and West Kent have provided over 1,486 children with a safe place to relax and develop essential life
- Horizons, our West Kent Training and Education service: provided alternative Post-16 education to
- 23 young people with SEND, helping them achieve 21 qualifications. An additional 26 local students joined day release programmes
- We're proud of Luke Shotter from our Goods Station Road shop, who won the national YMCA Young Achiever of the Year award. Luke has overcome adversity, inspired others, and become a true asset. Please join us in congratulating him and those who supported his journey
